Brian Tate, Clinician

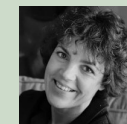
"I am very honoured and excited to be conducting the adult choir for Chorfest

A prolific composer and arranger, dozens of his choral works are published and his music is performed worldwide. Brian directs Vancouver's 100-voice City Soul Choir, teaches singing and choir at Studio 58 - Langara College's professional theatre school - and performs with the world music a cappella vocal trio "TriVo".

Brian has had a lifelong interest in music of the African Diaspora, and has travelled and studied in Cuba and West Africa. He frequently gives choir workshops and is in
