## **Election of Board of Directors**

#### Notice of Motion

**MOVE** (Chepyha/Carrington) to establish the choir membership year as November 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>, instead of being valid for one year from purchase. This motion would take effect immediately. (This motion was carried at the BCCF Board meeting on January 27, 2018.)

**MOVE** (Chepyha/Hagerman) to increase BC Choral Federation annual membership fees as follows: from \$50 to \$75 for choirs, from \$25-\$30 to \$40 for individuals, and from \$75 to \$100 for institutions. (This motion was carried at the BCCF Board meeting on January 27, 2018.)

**MOVE** (Hagerman/Chepyha) to set the BC Choral Federation corporate membership fee to \$100. (This motion was carried at the BCCF Board meeting on May 29, 2016.)

The corporate membership category is open to any person or organization who subscribes to and supports the objectives of the Federation, but who is not actively engaged in making choral music. Corporate members may observe at general and special meetings and receive public correspondence, invitations and reduced rates (where available) to special Federation events. The proposed member must do business within the Province of BC.
